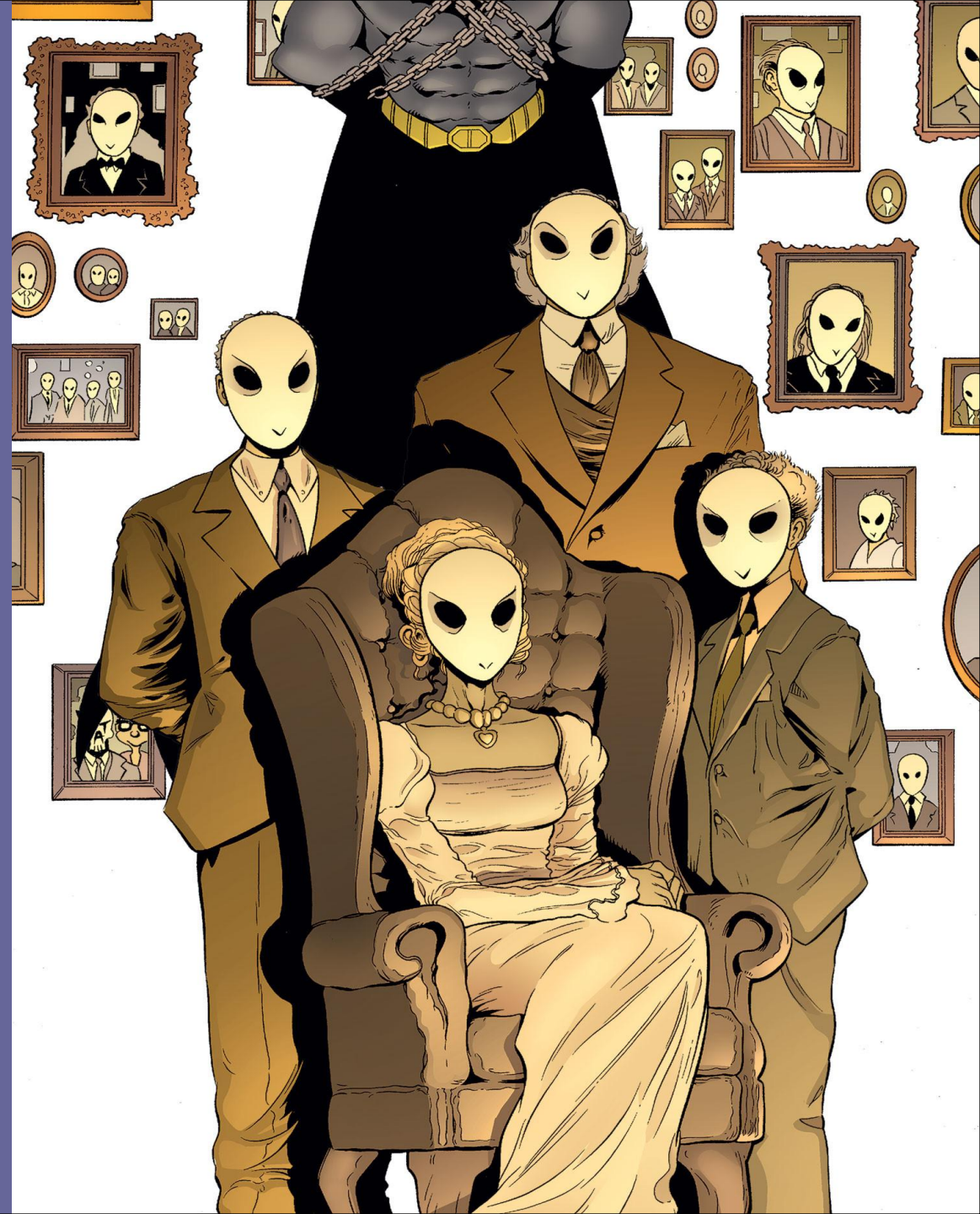
Serial Murder

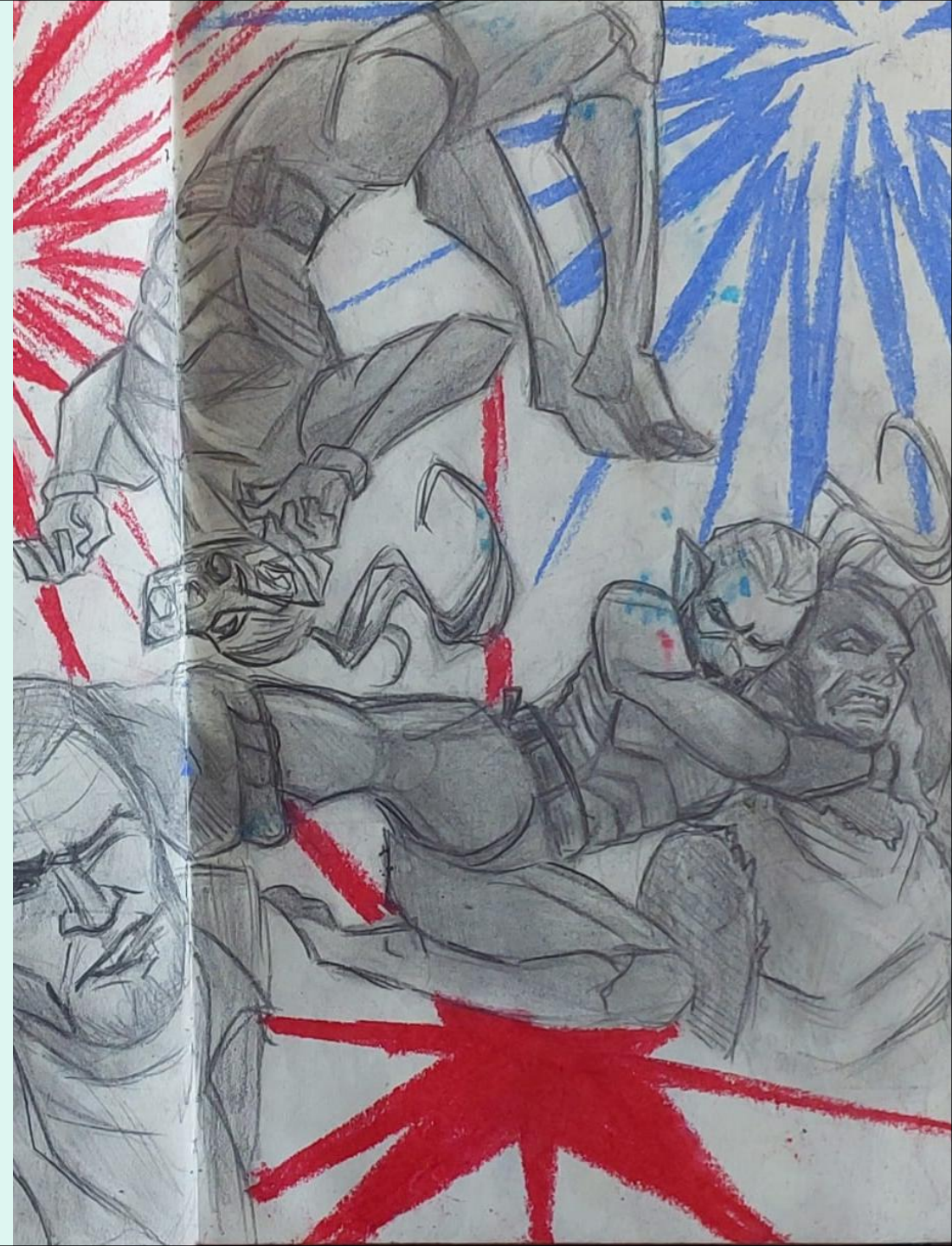

Fries explained that the nanotechnology in them was connected to Brainiac and had replaced all her cells. This nanotechnology was also able to put a mud-child into a coma.



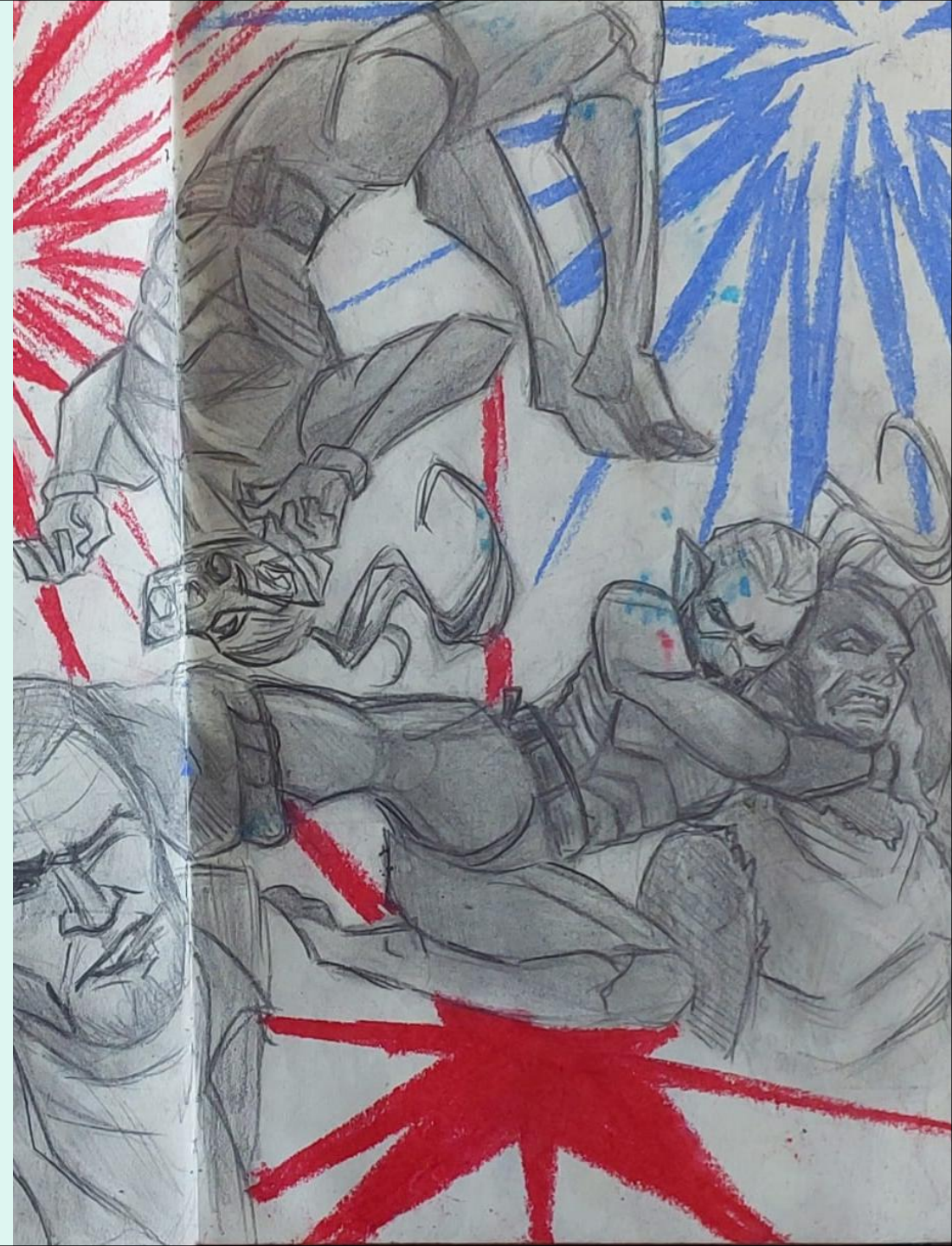

coming from the body into a warehouse. It seemed Hugo Strange was back, and he wanted something with Lee.



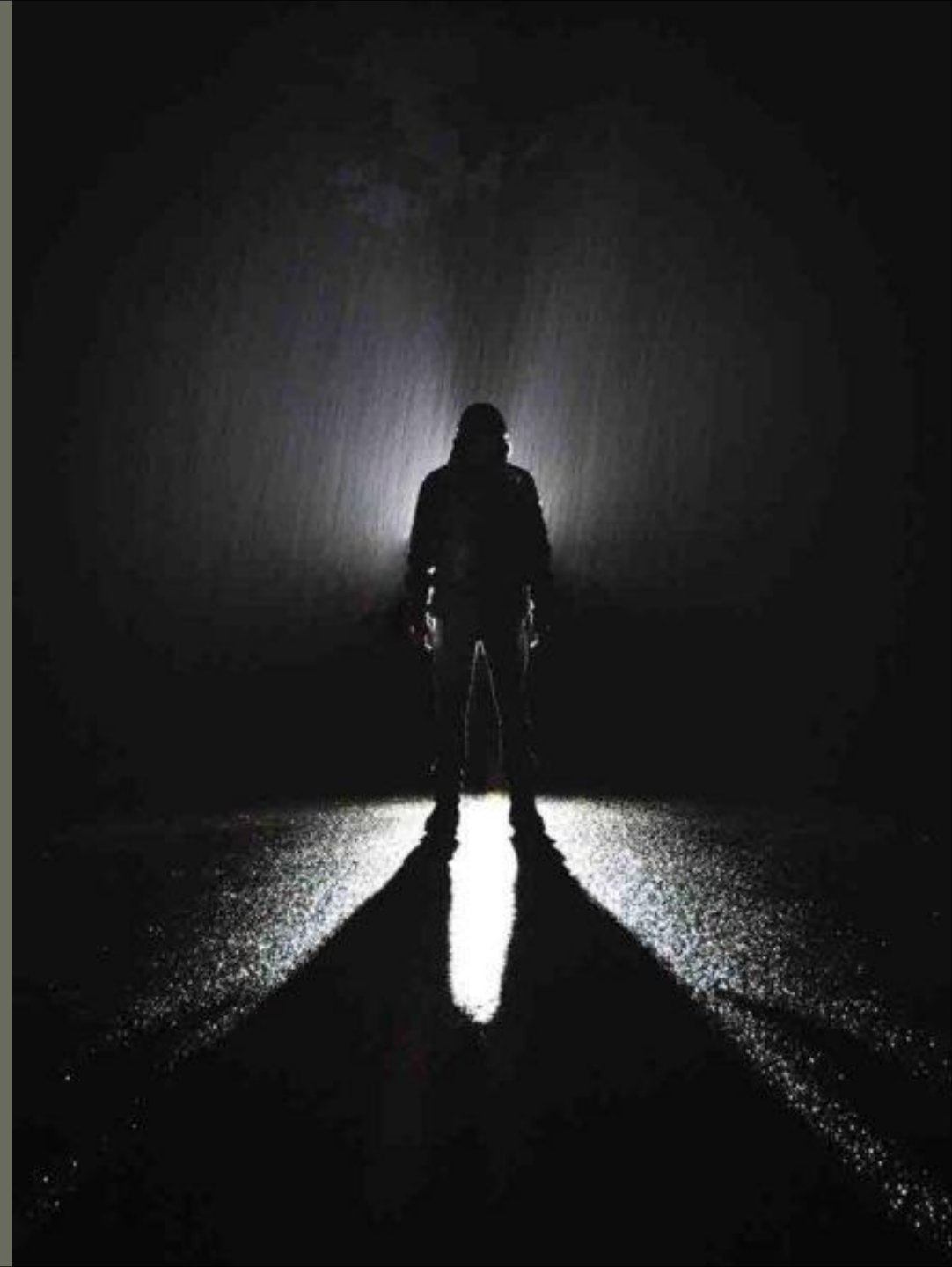
Lyev Shans

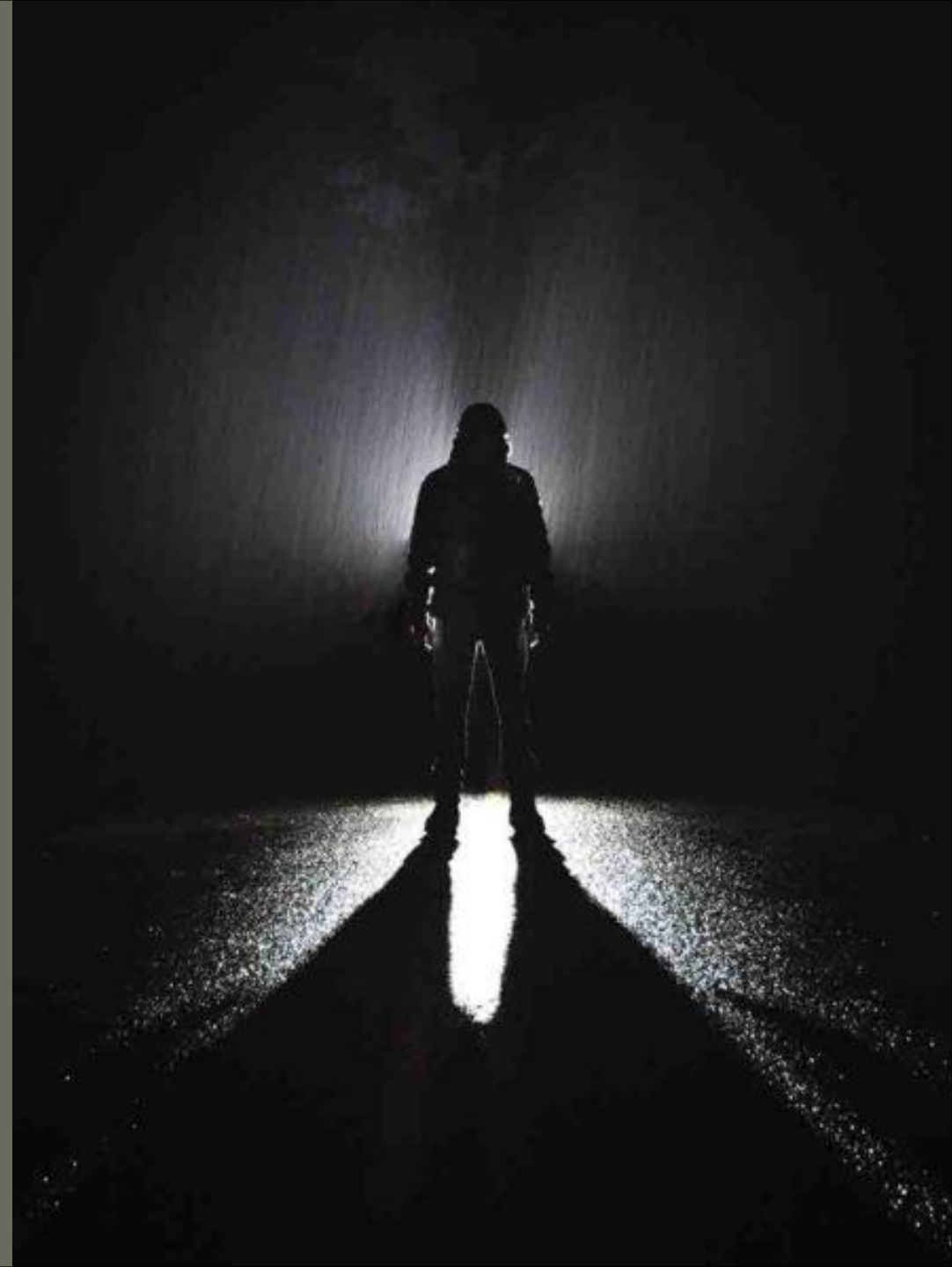

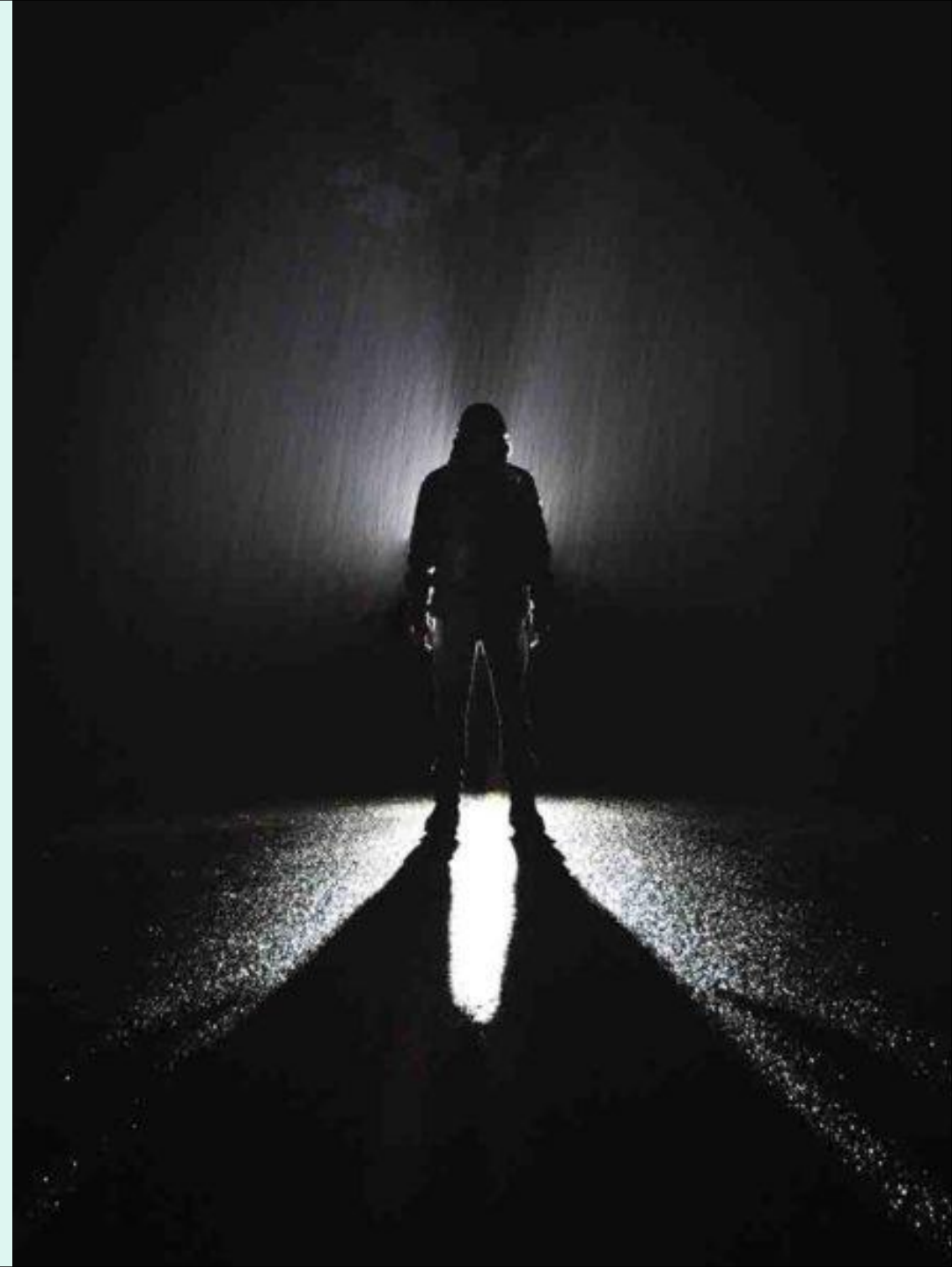

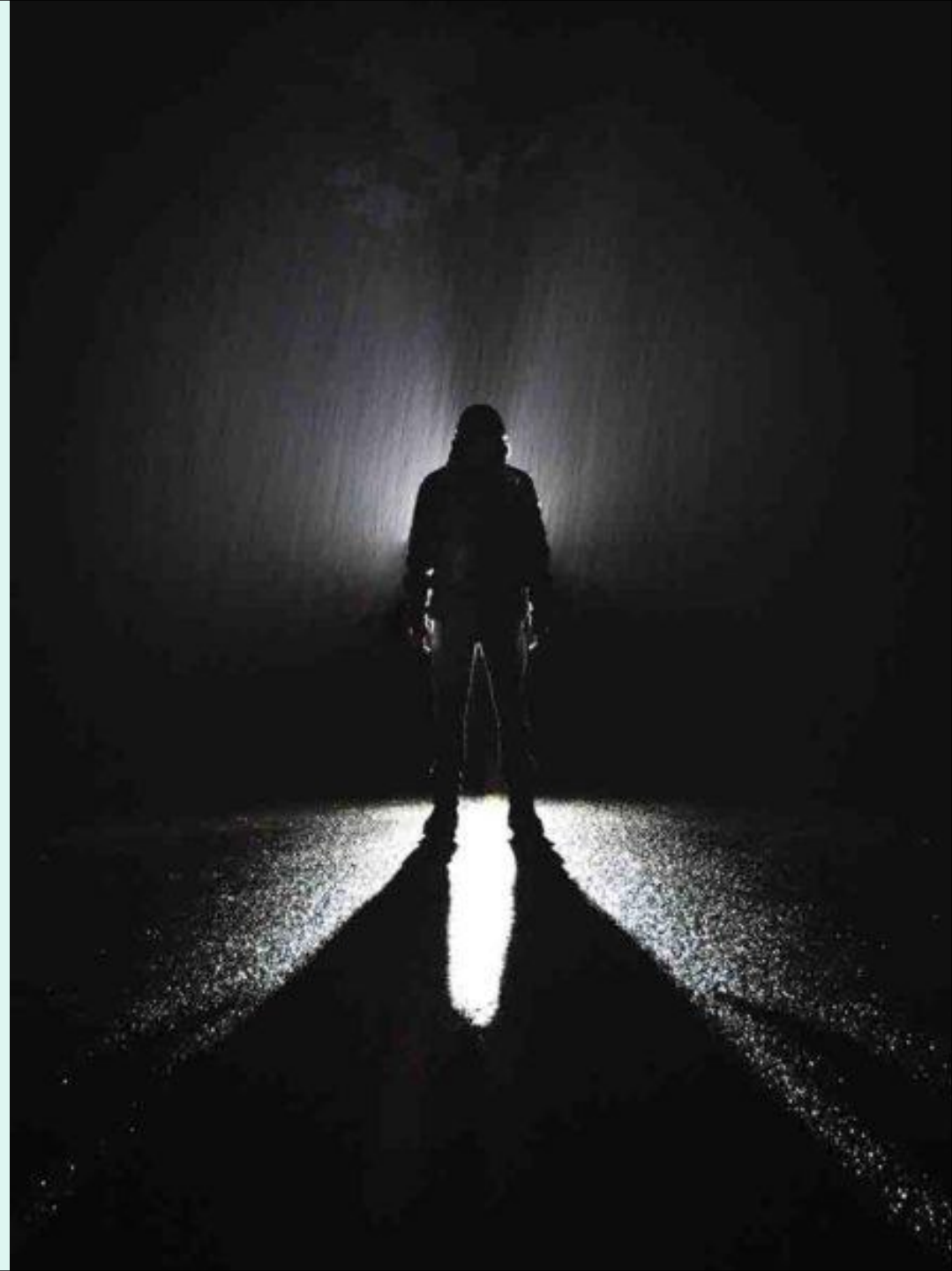

There was a rat, though, and Penguin found out who had beat his men half to death and destroyed his plaything. In an unfair fight, Robert was put up against Sickle in the arena, and he

Robert later used a hallucination to prove to the Order of Saint Dumas that he should be leading them. When Riddler murdered his mother and tried to



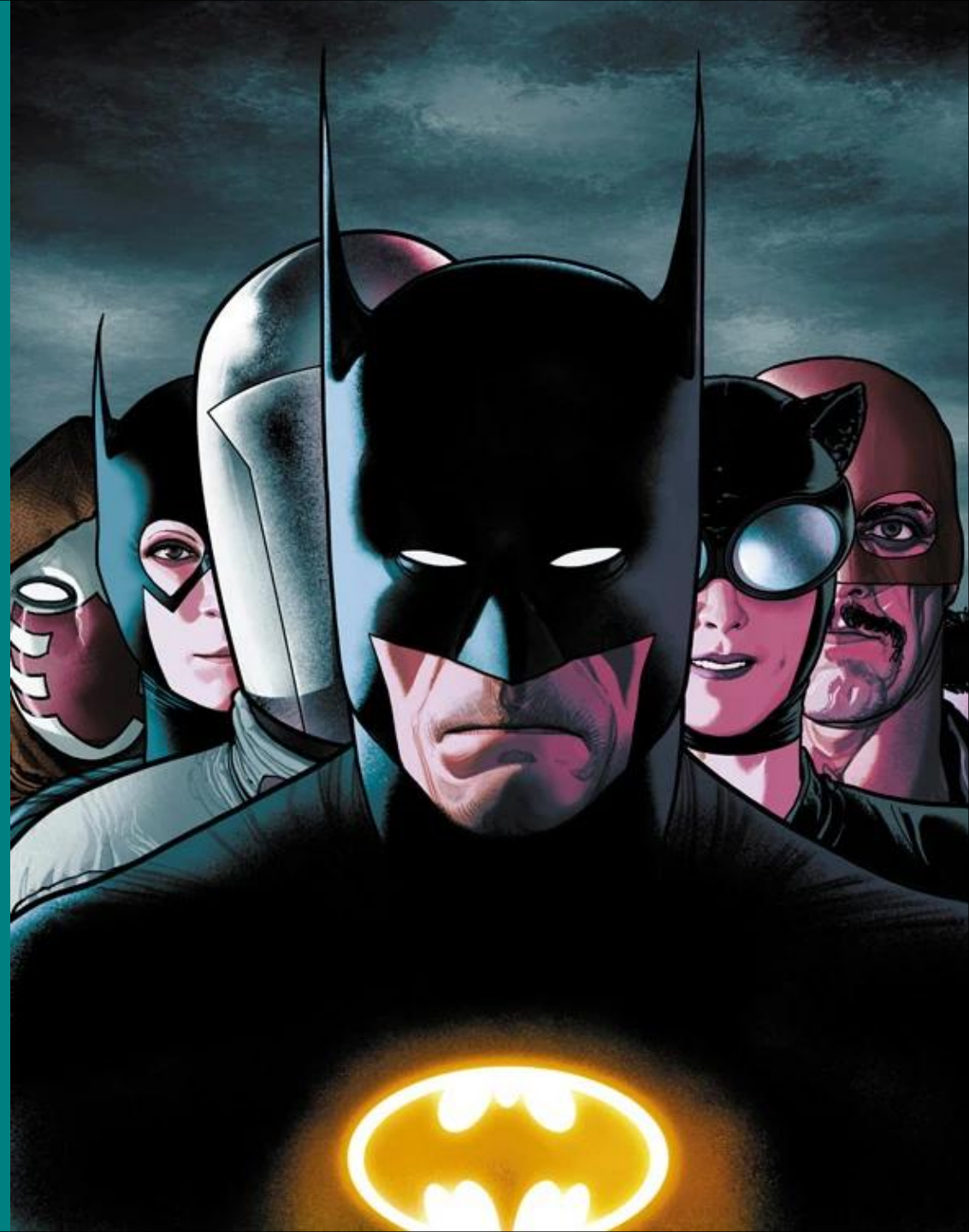

The group was of severe importance to the betterment of Gotham. From getting food and water to directly helping those whose life was ruined by the fall of Gotham. Starting on Otisburg, the Special Ops Unit was able to spread to The Hell, Dead Man's Summit, North Burnside, and Dahlia Avenue, making many allies along the way.



Alexander Wells

Before becoming Commander Bee, Wells fought in the Bialyan liberation war through Checkmate's Operation Hivemind, which separated Bialya from Iraq, setting up Behnaz Kasebi, Queen Bee, as leader of the newly-separated Bialya. Wells was named Commander Bee by Behnaz after his heroic efforts saved her more

than once. The mission was completed, but Wells realized not only how their goal was faulty, but also that the way other operatives worked, and sometimes how he himself worked, bordered on criminal, if not surpassed all law and morals. Wells attempted to blow the whistle on the entire operation, but was instead

dishonorably discharged and threatened with death if he continued. Former commissioner James Gordon helped him get justice to some of the people who committed atrocities in Operation Hivemind, and ended up hiring Wells, now calling himself Commander Bee, for a Special Ops team connected to the GCPD.

Commander Bee helped the team in several situations after the fall of Gotham. He aided in the search for water, in the incursion into the Iceberg Lounge, and in the Great Gang War. After the incursion, Bee stayed out of action to be with severely injured Birdboy. In the War, Bee was stabbed in the back, but recovered after surgery.



Barbara Gordon

Barbara's parents died when she was a toddler. Her uncle, James Gordon, took her in after that. An extremely intelligent girl, Barbara graduated early and enrolled in Gotham U. at 16 with a Wayne Foundation scholarship. She looked up to Batman and Robin, and when her father was being held up by Killer Moth, she dressed in a

self-made bat-costume, and saved him. Batman eventually accepted to train her and she became Batgirl. Long years passed, side-by-side with Batman. Until Harley Quinn happened. as Oracle. Helping the Batfamily as their eyes, ears, and information gatherer.



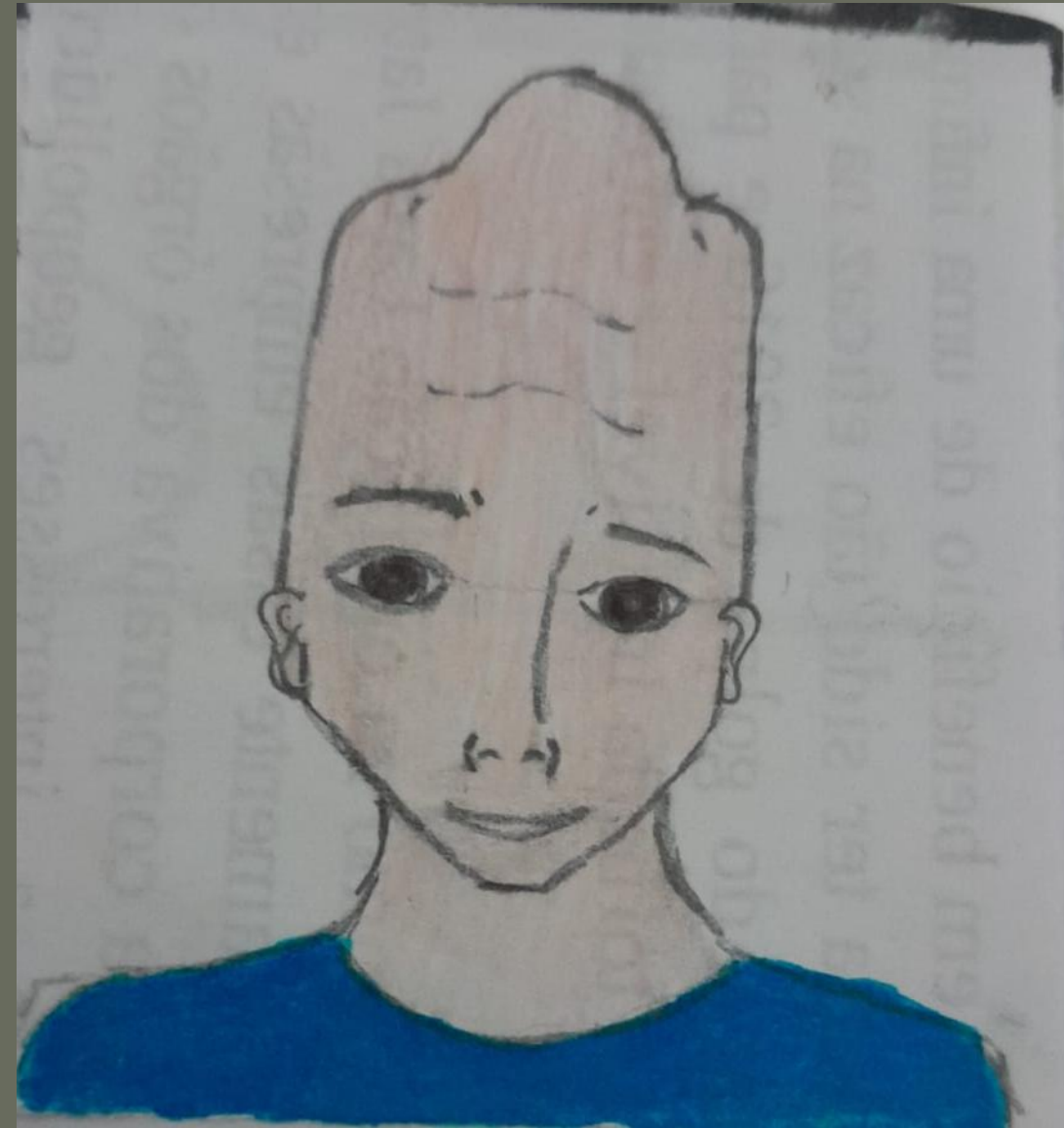

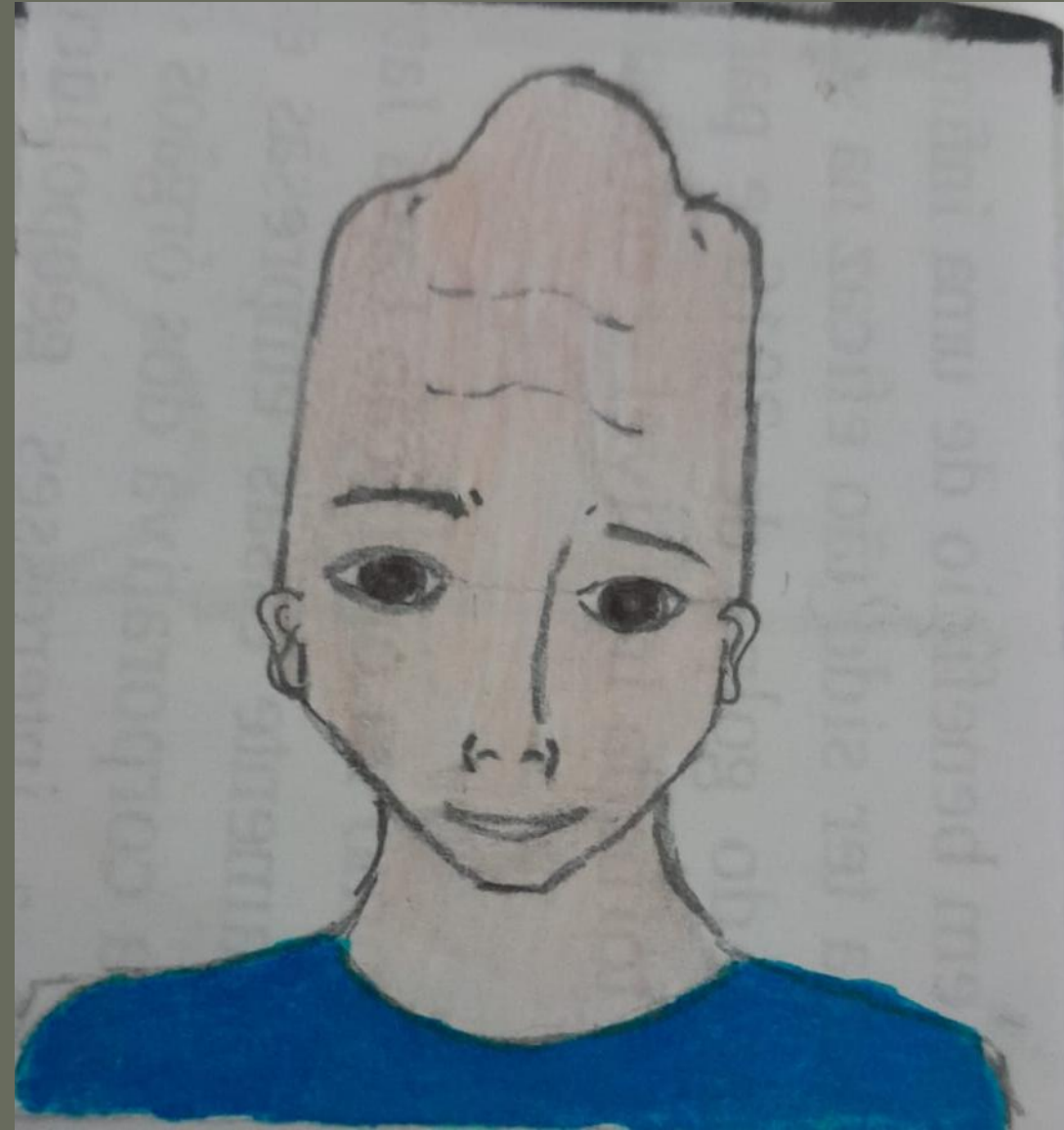
Elliot Allen

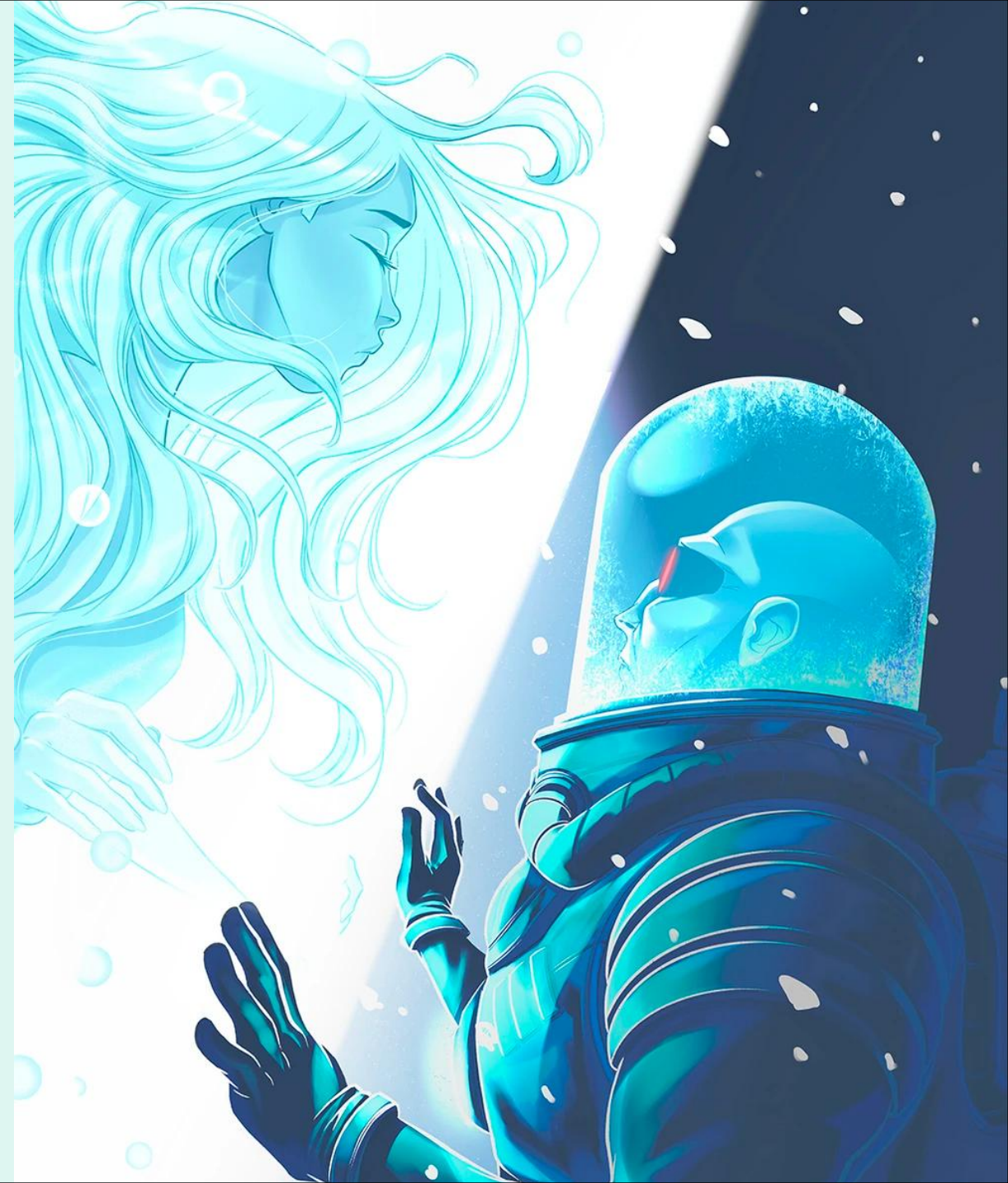
Victor Fries

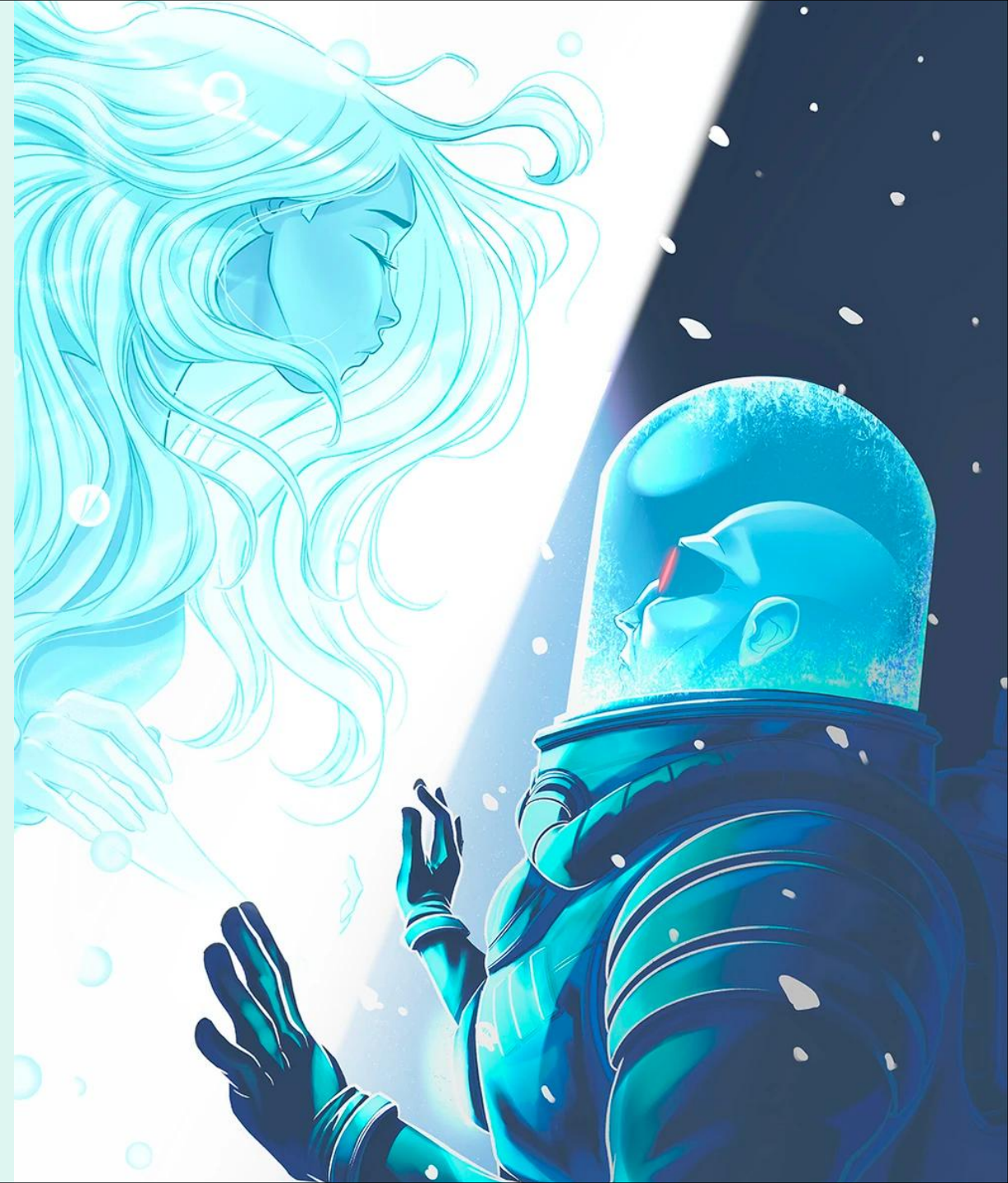

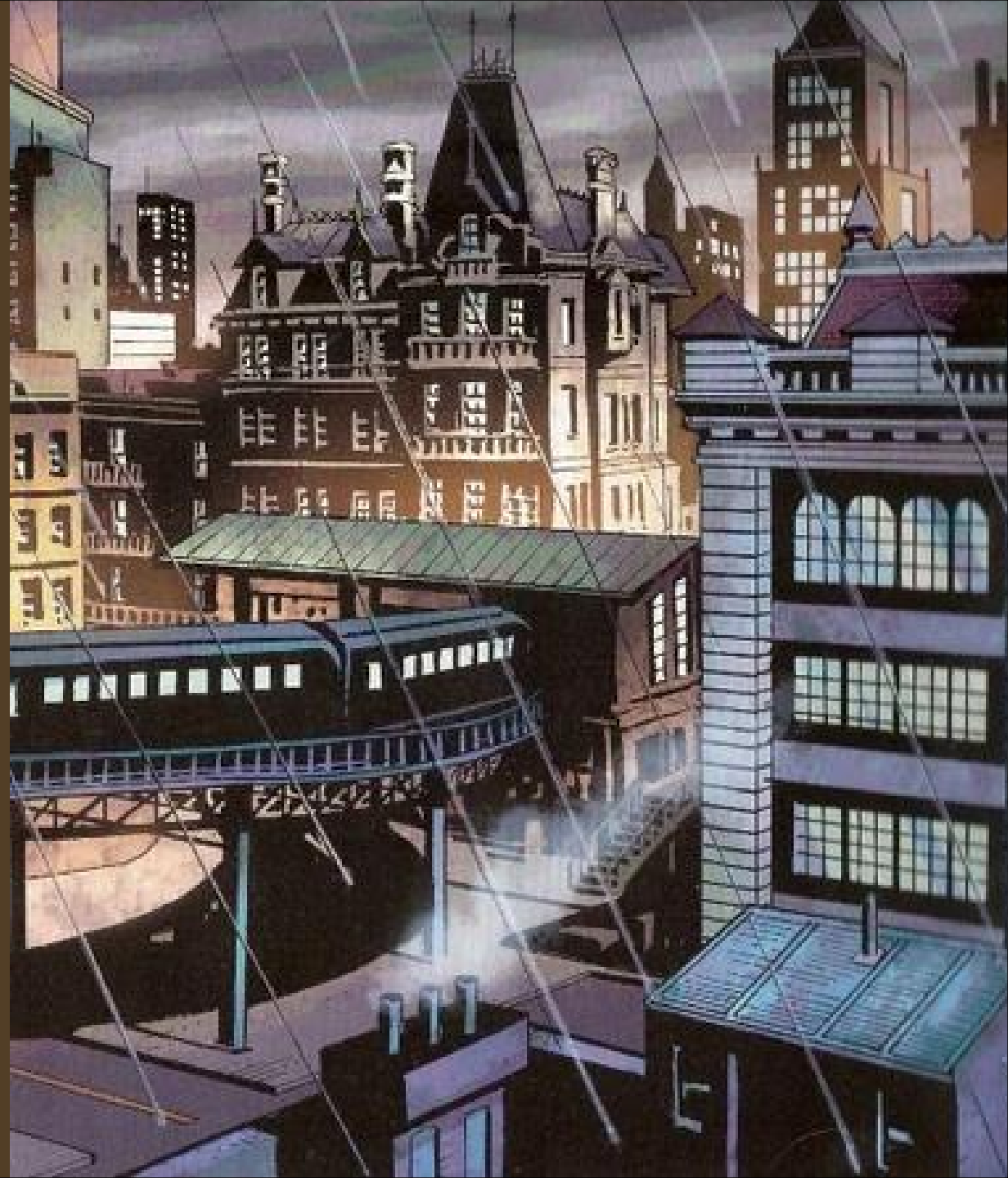

them by so many. They would help each other through this crisis.



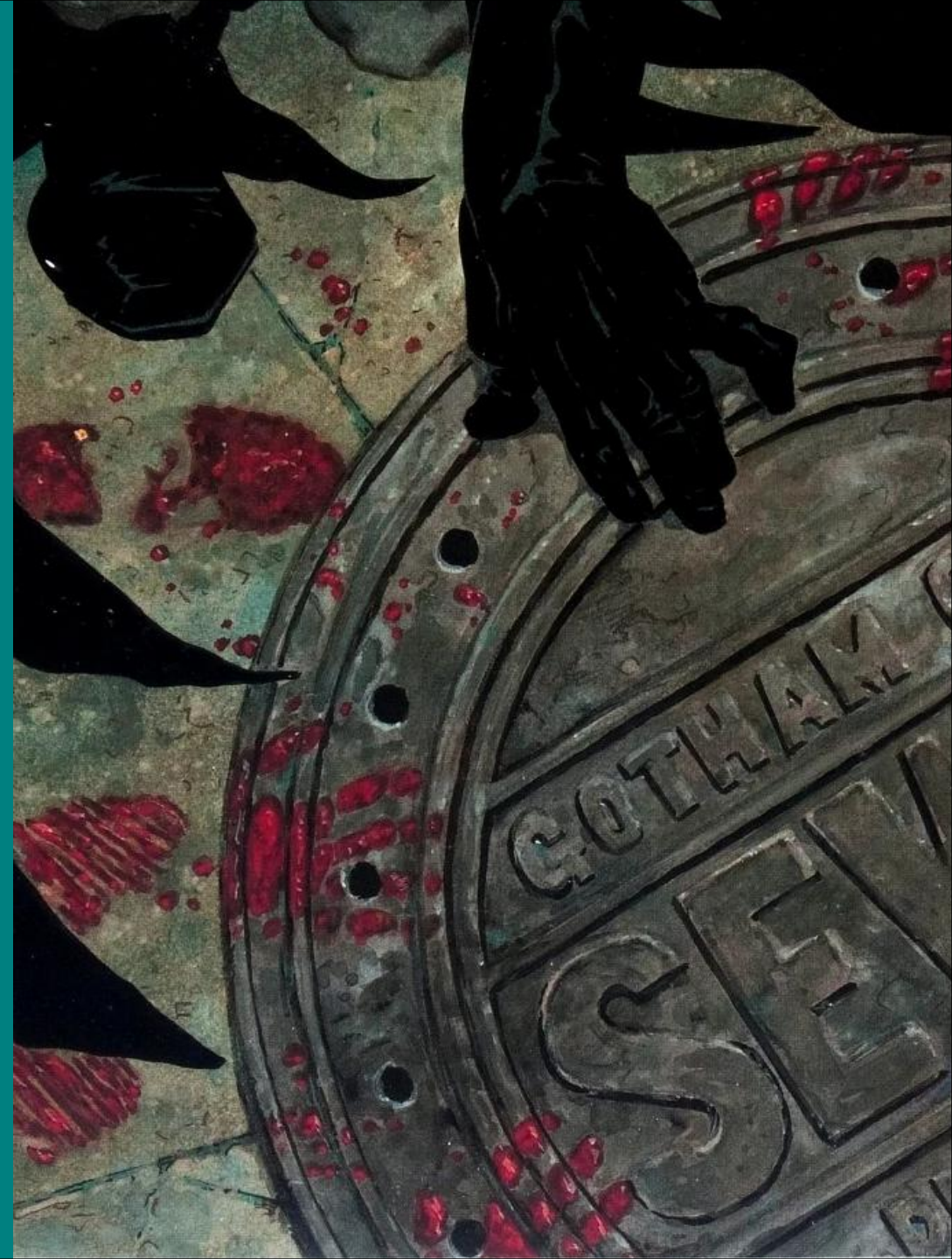
Slaughter Swamp

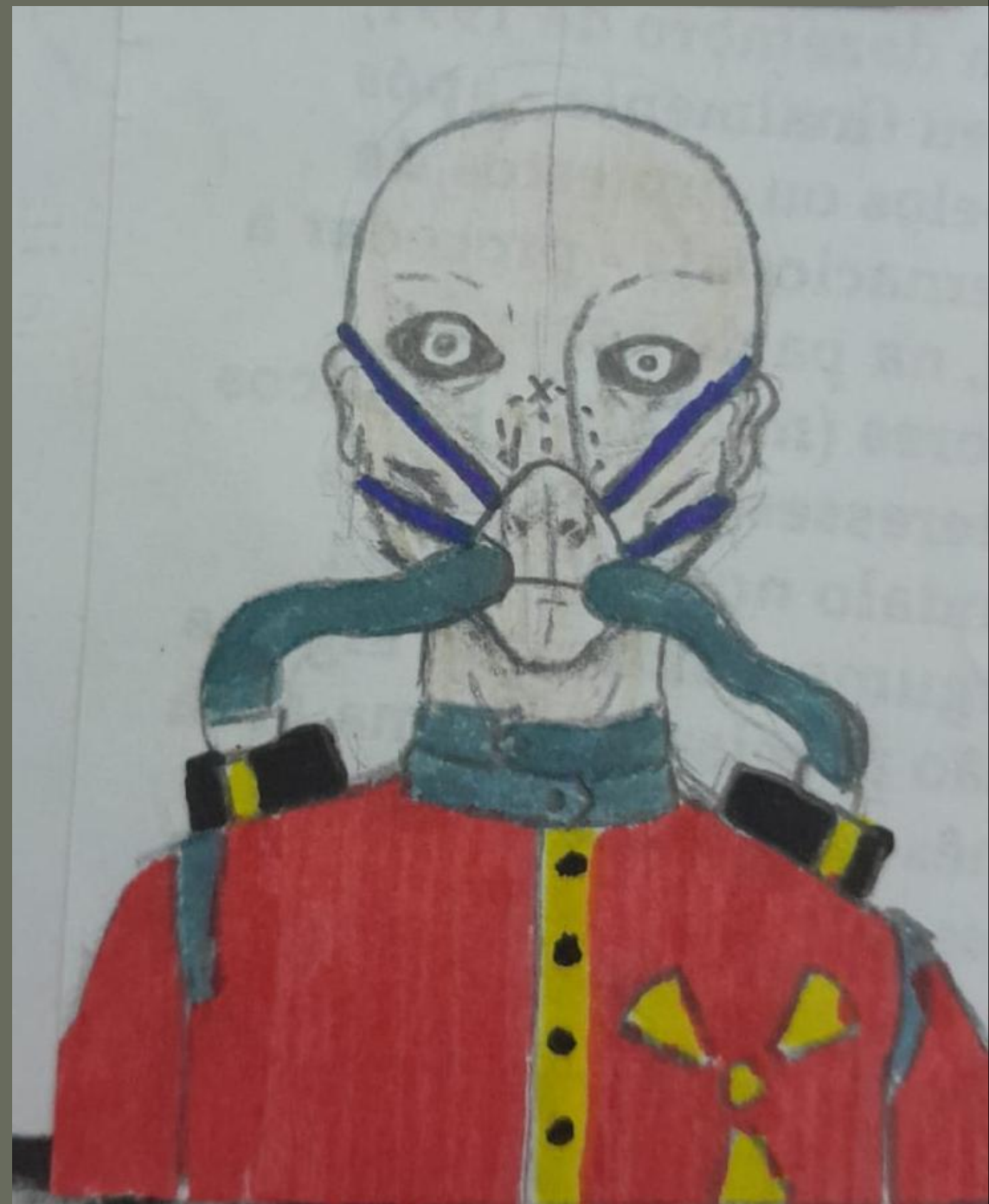
Drury Walker

Charaxes was one of the Blackfire Cultists who fought in the Great Gang War. His wings were ripped out of his body. There was no one who could save him.



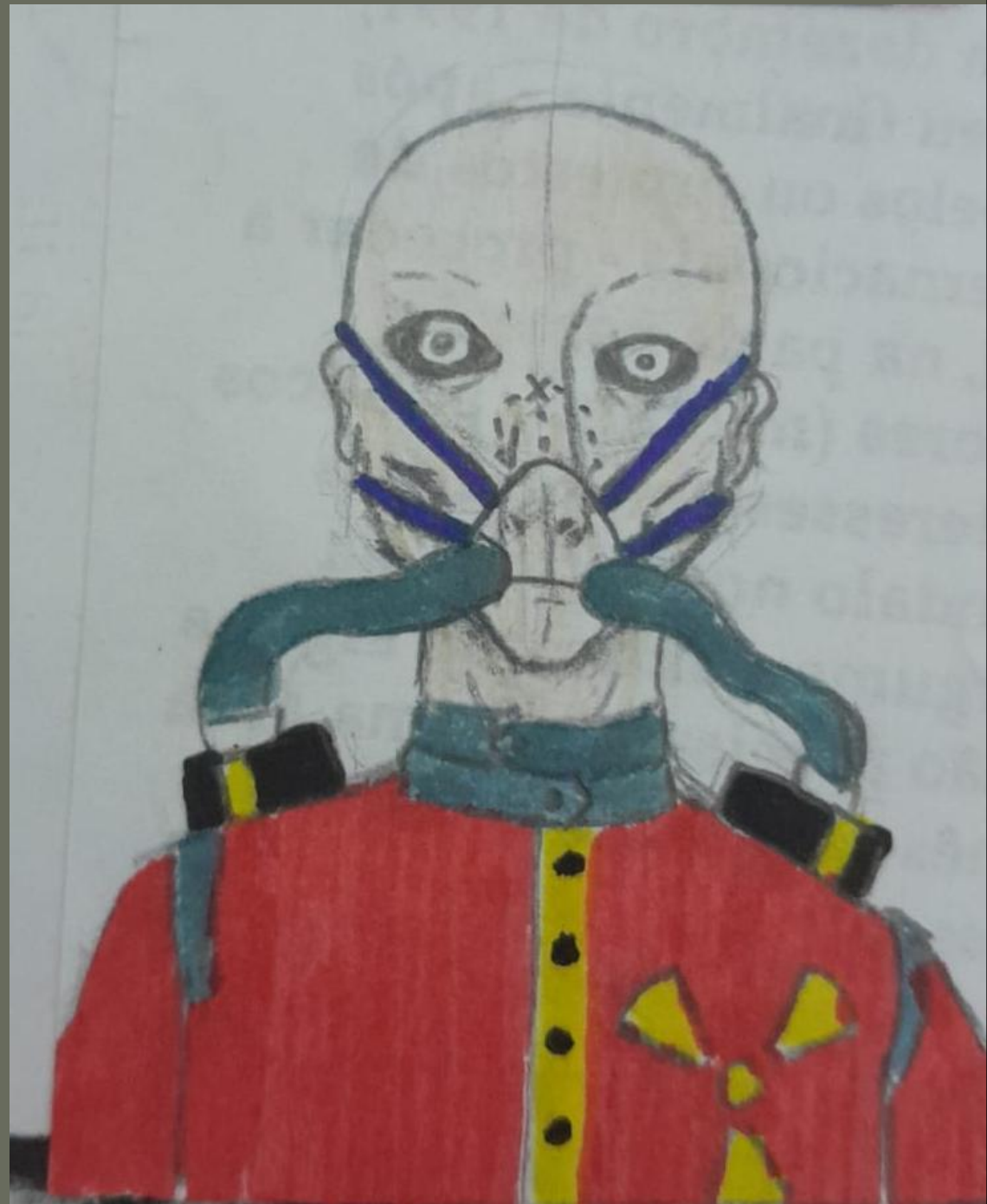
Emmanuel James

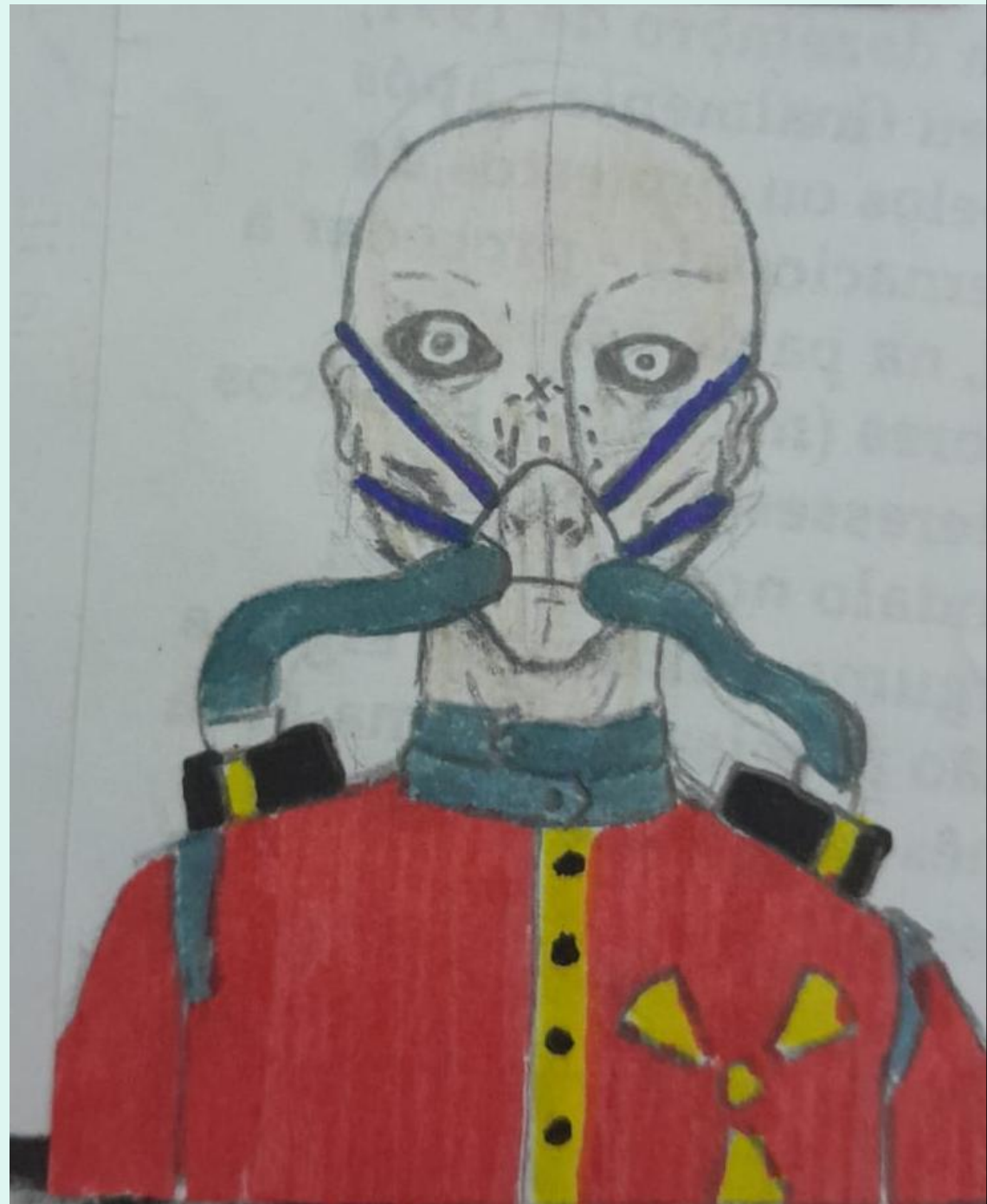
Emmanuel James

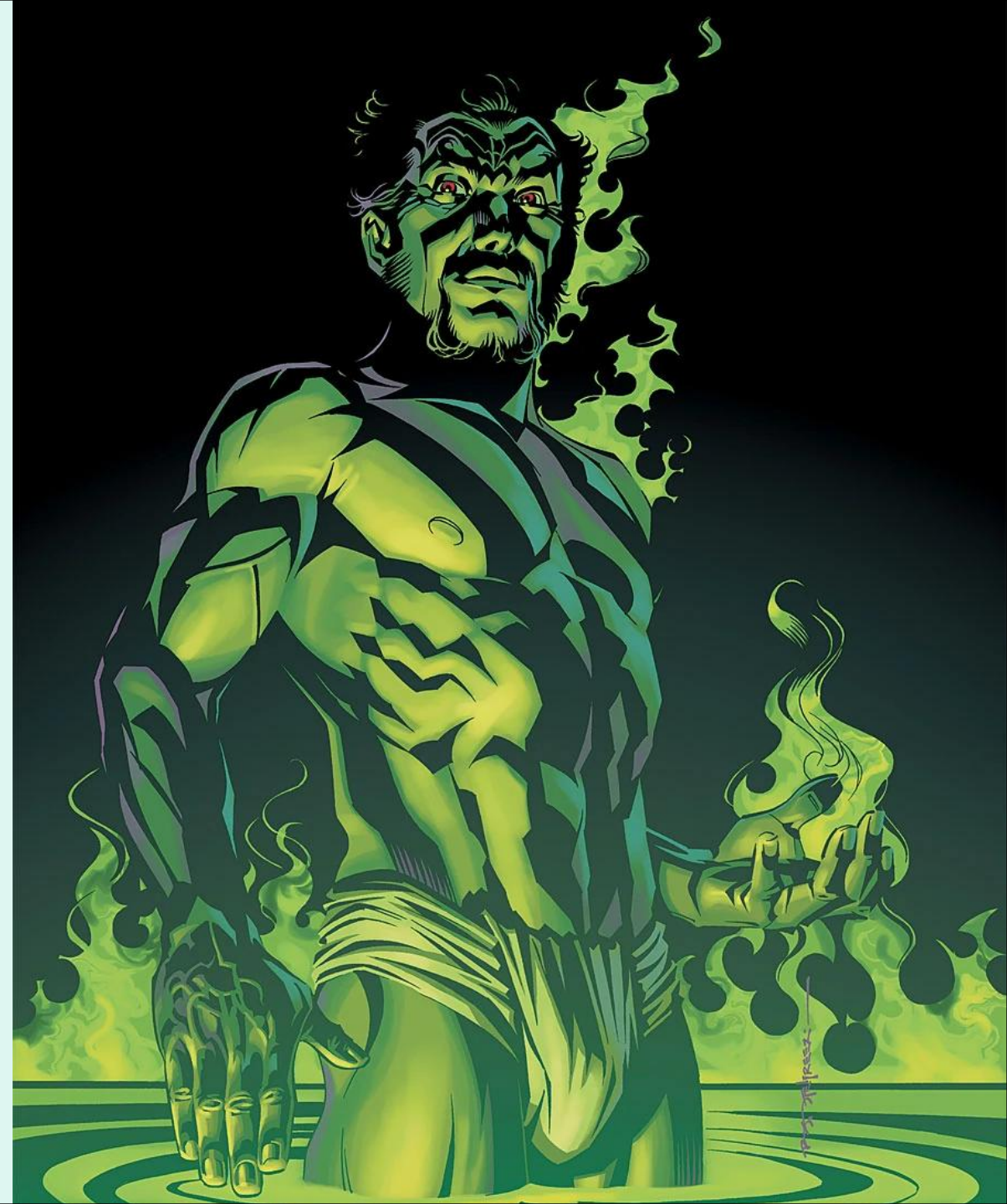
Ra's-al-Ghul

Alex used her training as a contortionist to become a thief. She is not known to have ever killed anyone. After being caught by the Penguin, she stopped talking to people.



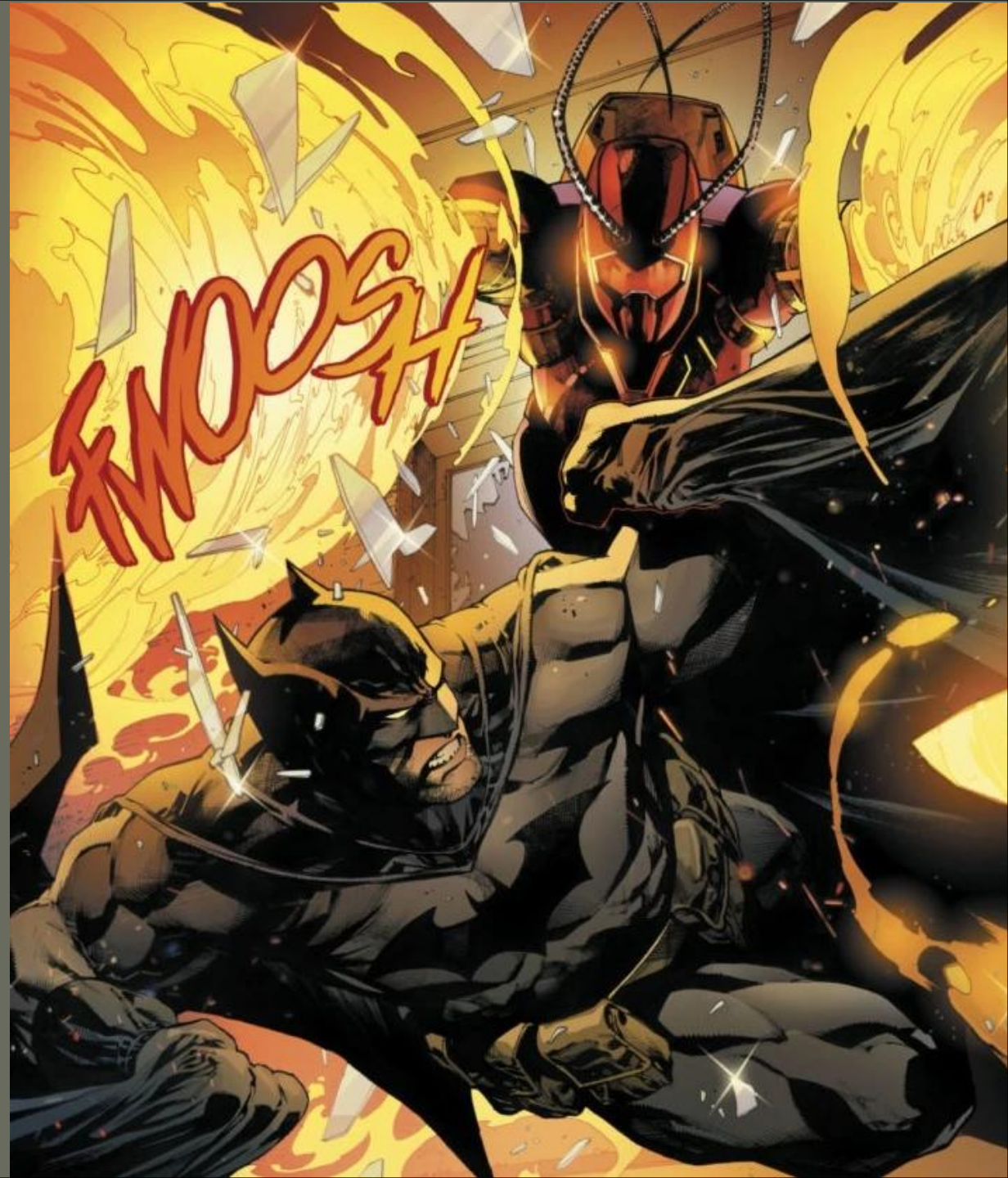

Ragdoll helped the team in the Great Gang War, leading the strike to Sofia Falcone.



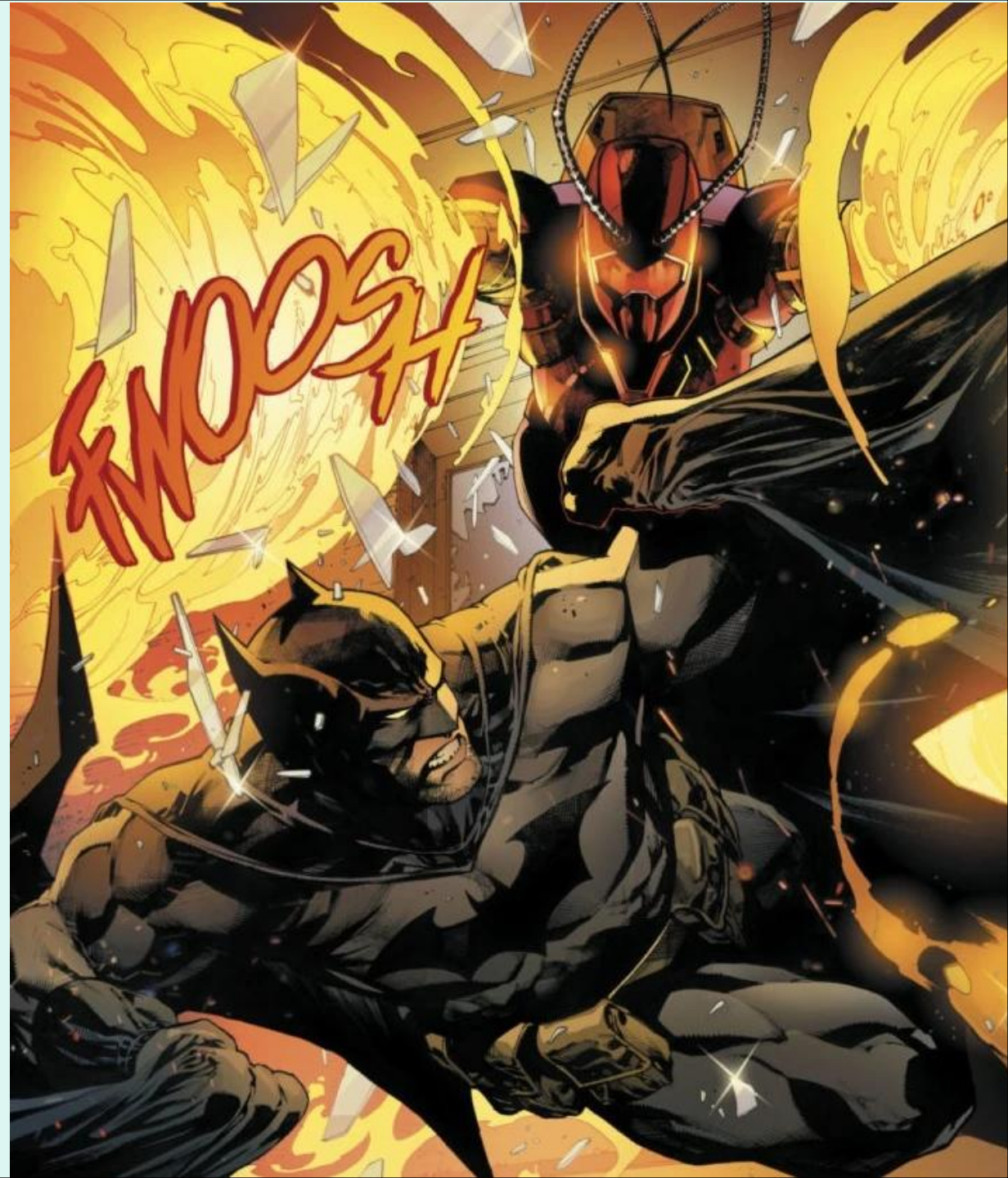
Bridgit Pike

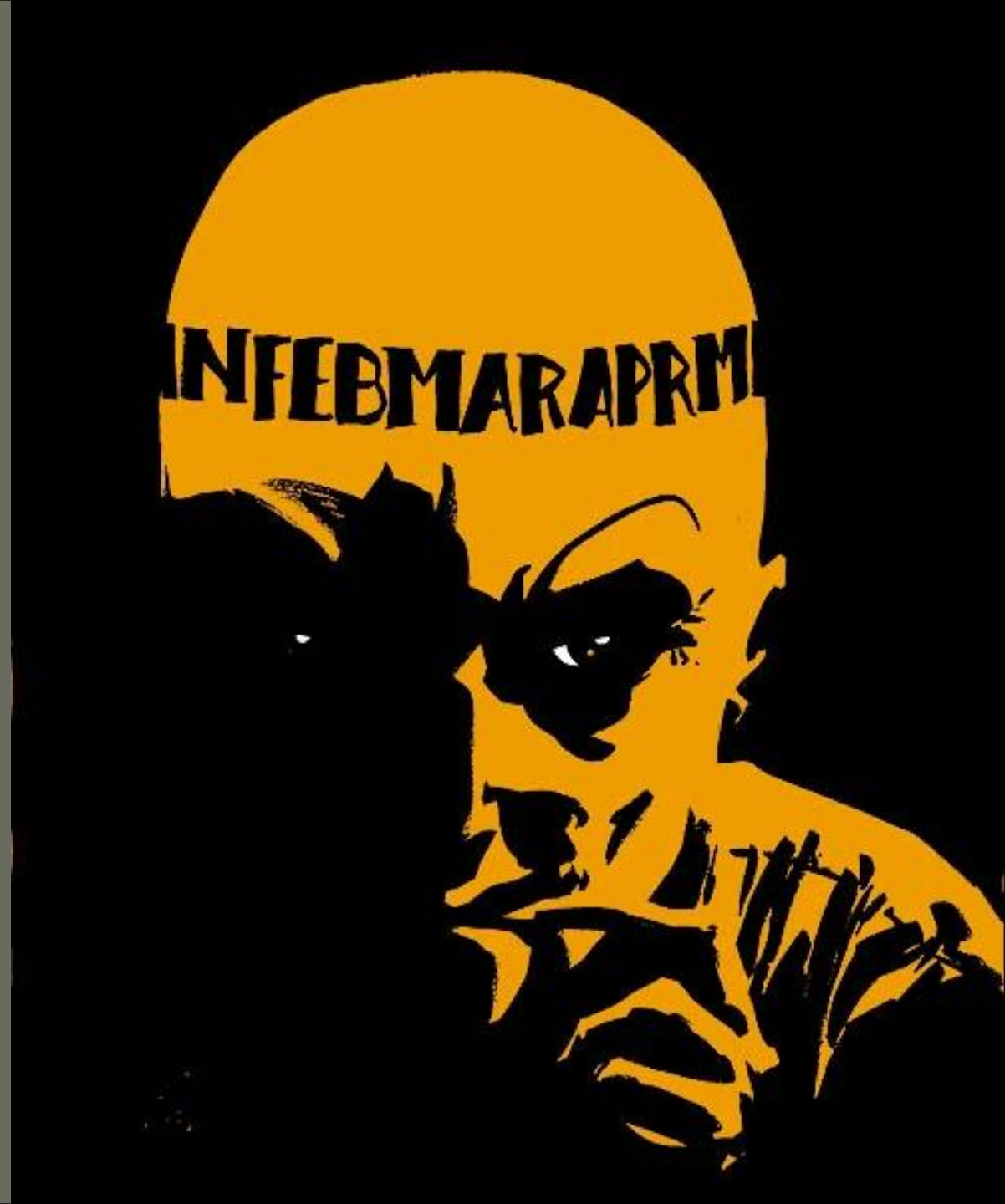

Calendar-Man was still in contact with Cat-Man when Gotham fell. They remade the Misfits and took over Diamond District. Julian helped in the Great Gang War.



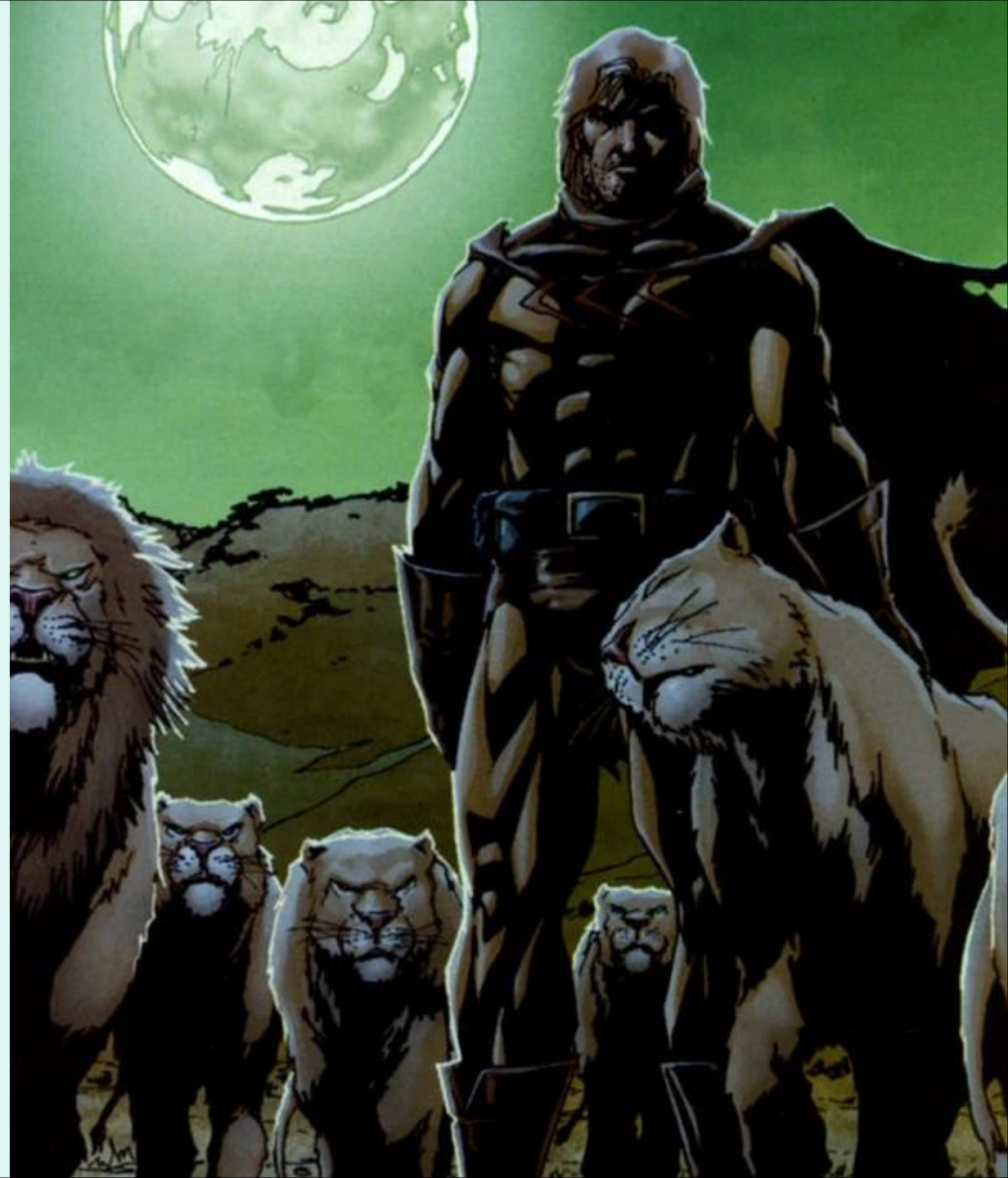
Thomas Blake

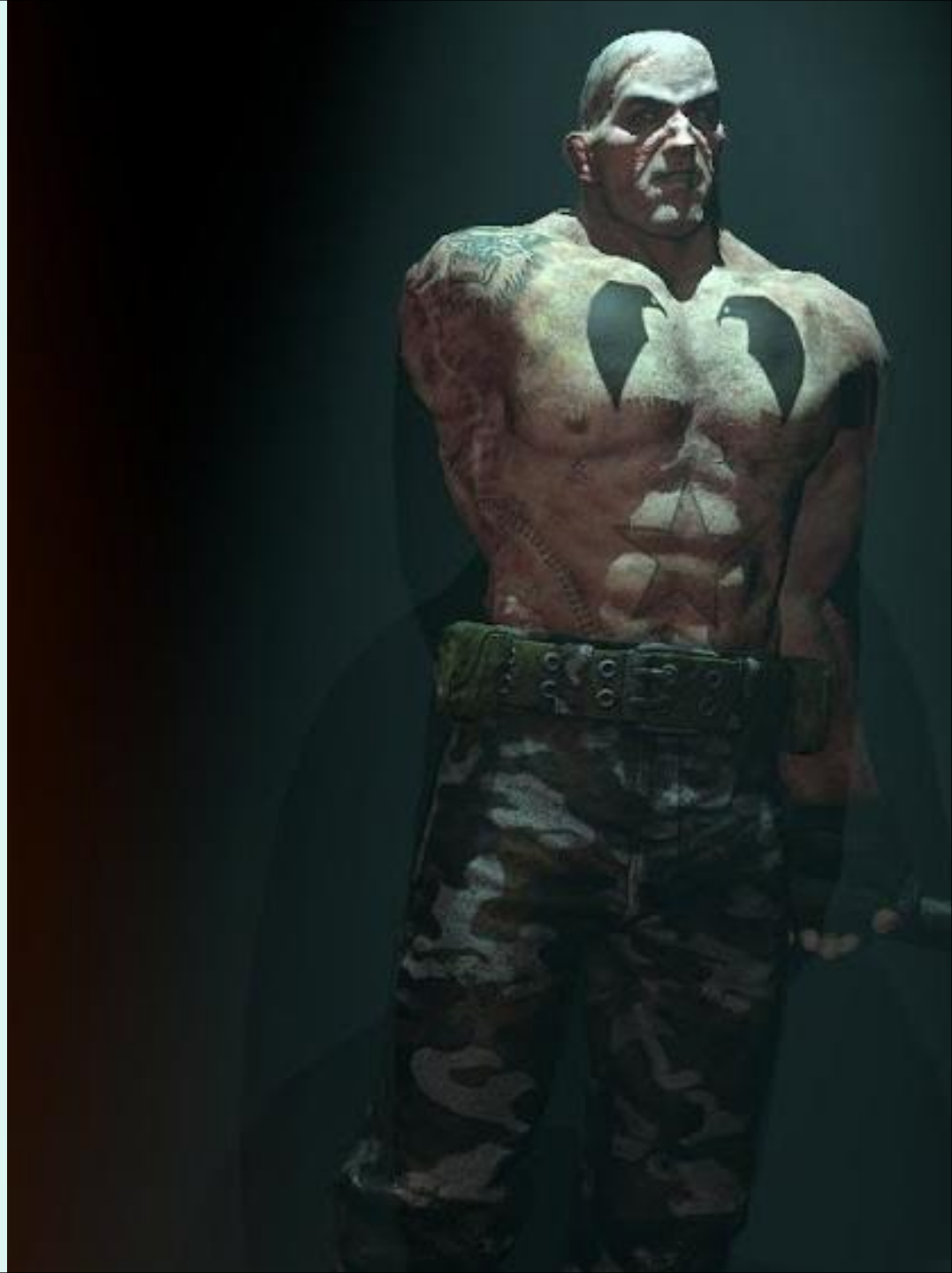
Nikolai Abramovich

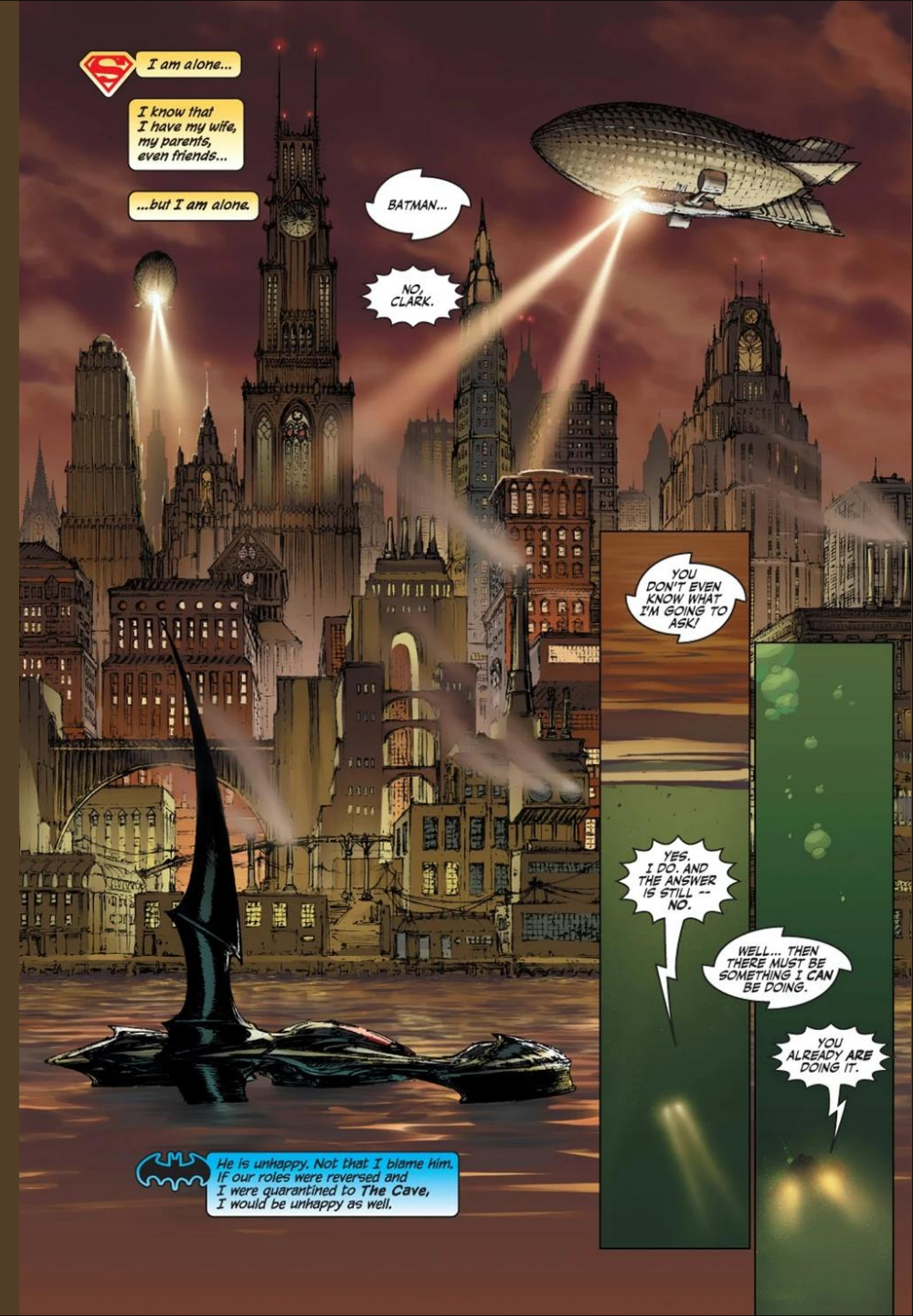
Central Gotham

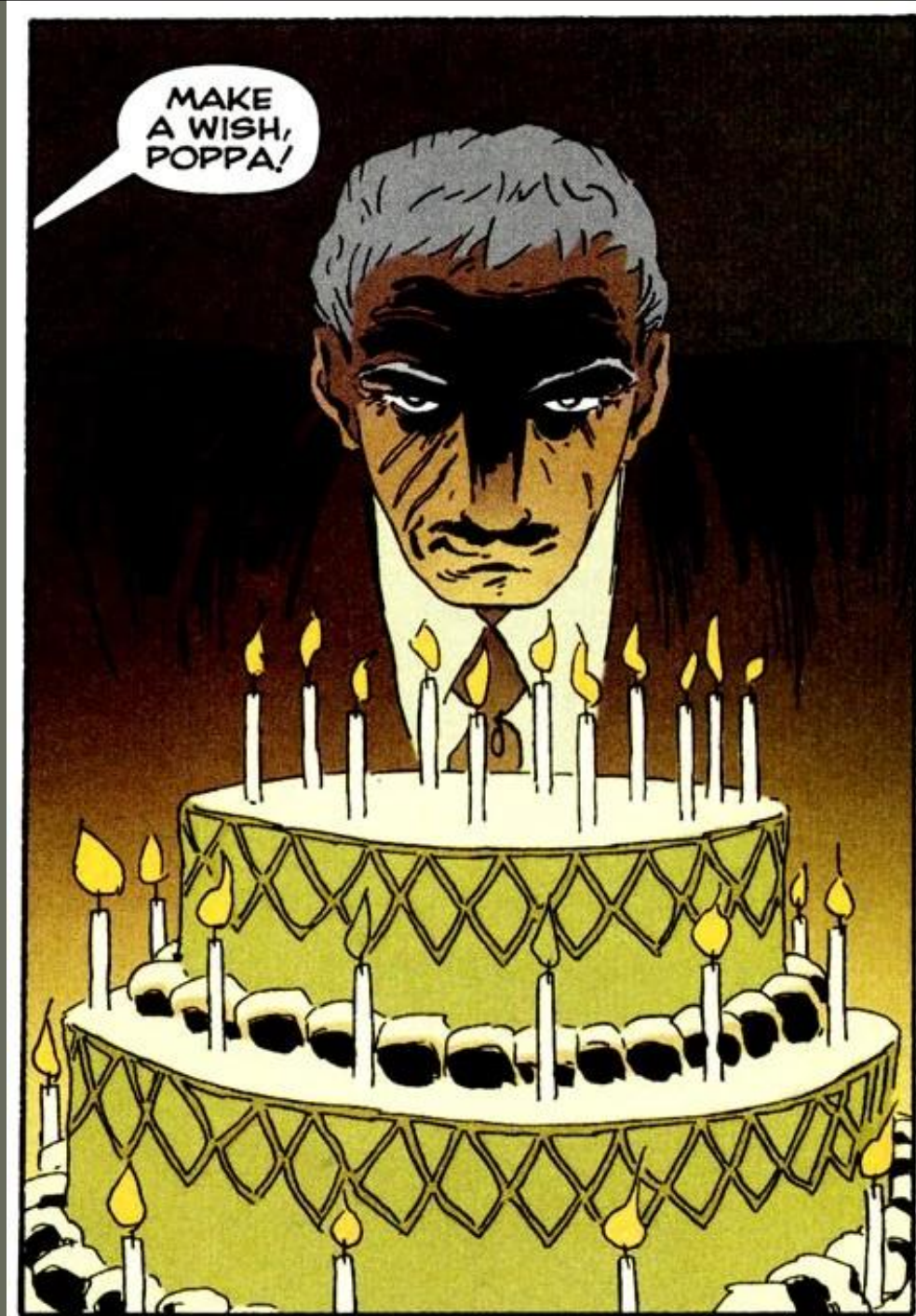

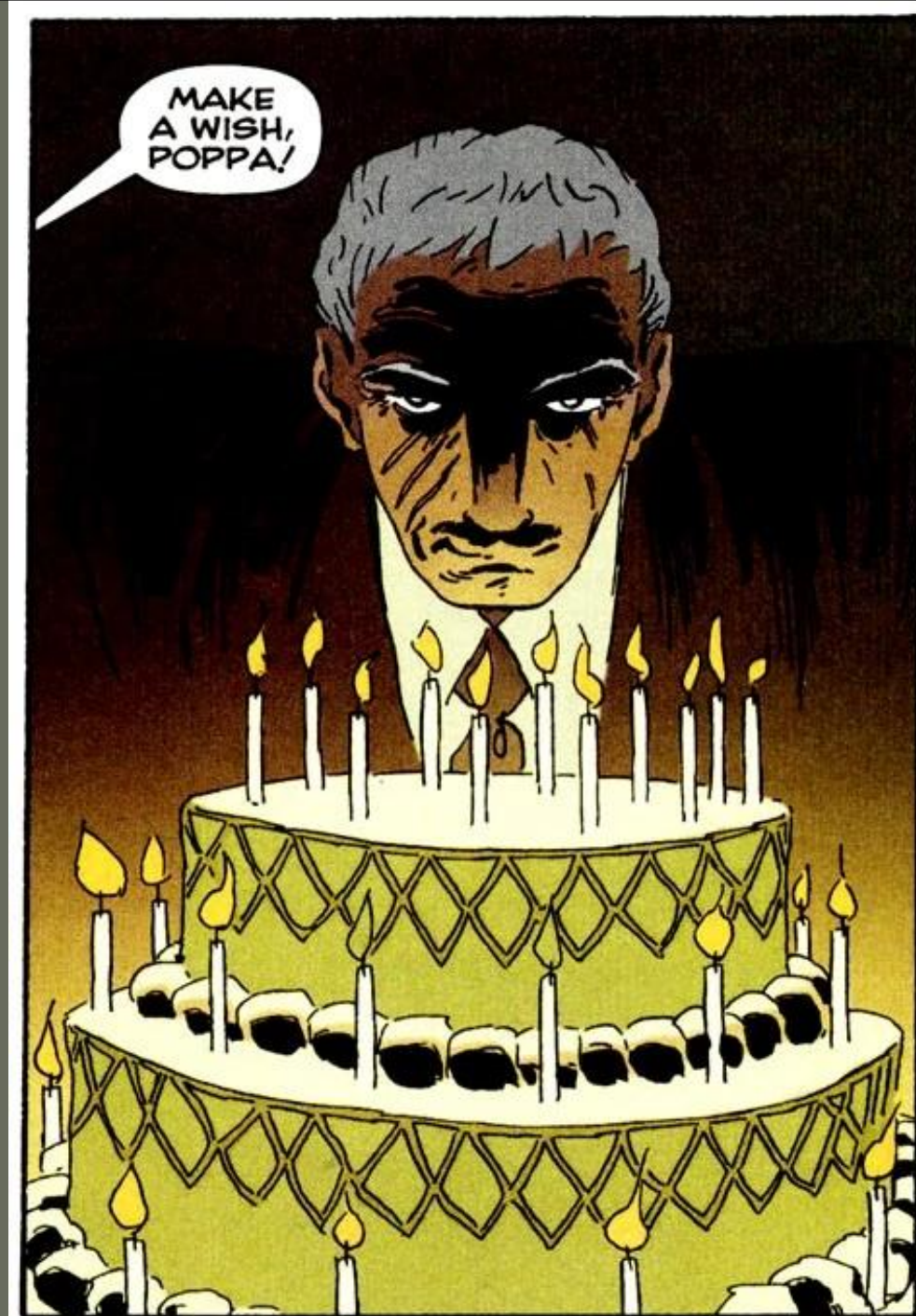
Carmine Falcone

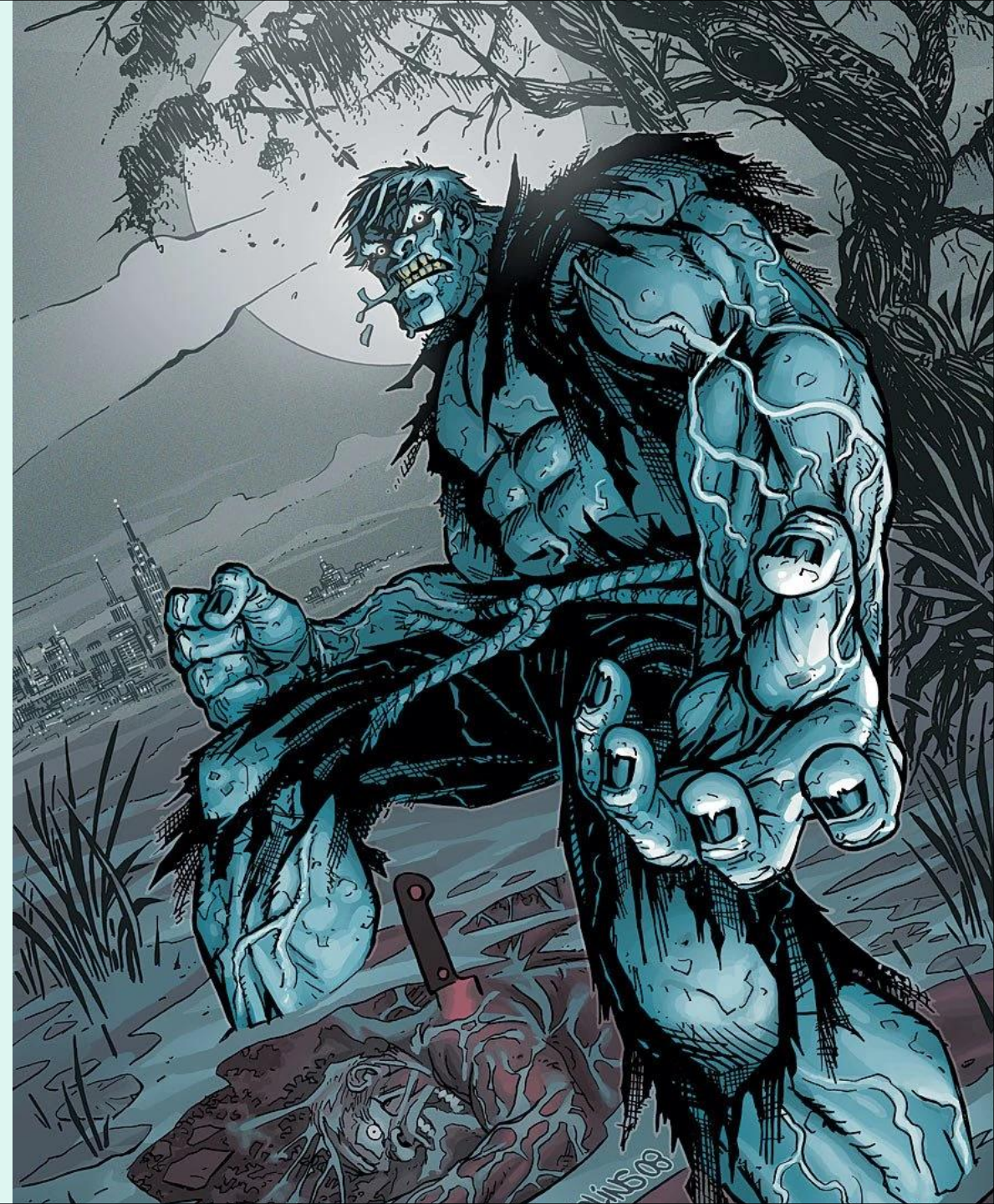
Solomon Grundy

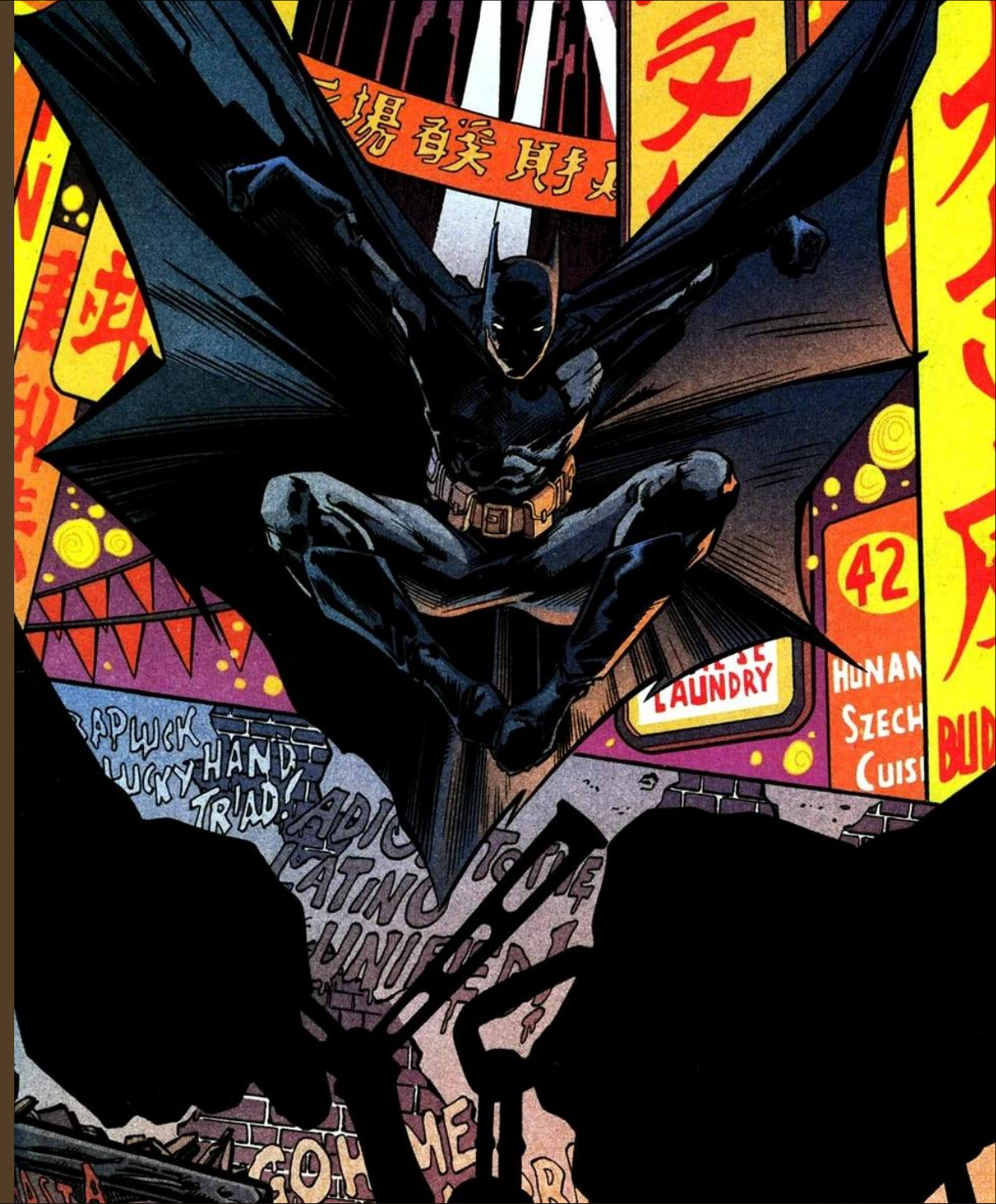
The Triad

Led by Luka Volk, they hold the subways and charge for safe passage through zones of control.



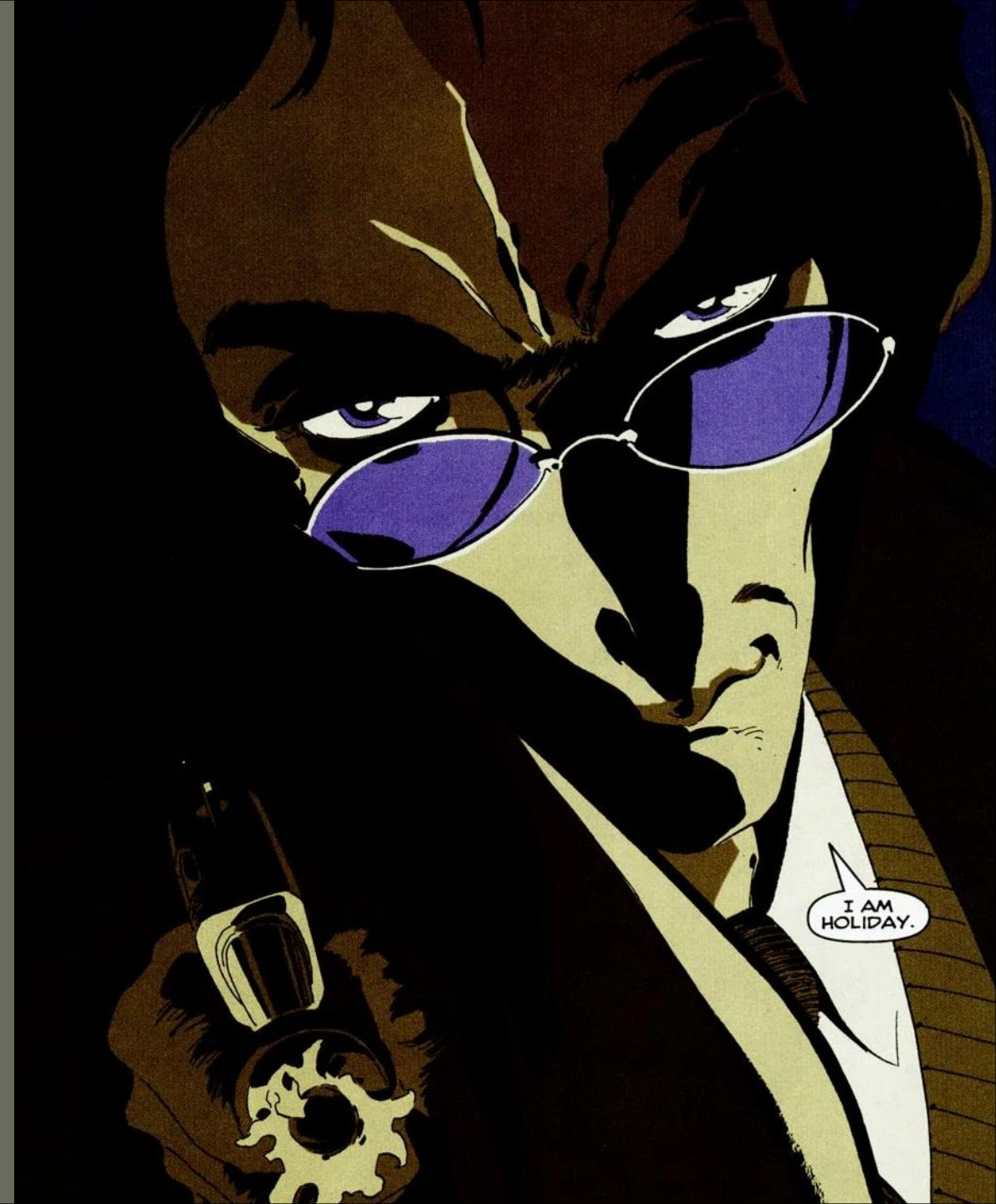
Populus
